Overview: The 18th Mini Print International is a juried exhibition of prints no larger than 4"x4". A maximum of three(3) original prints in any traditional or contemporary graphic process, including computer generated prints, will be accepted. Photographs are not admitted unless they are computer manipulated.

Juror: Laurie Snyder received her BFA from Cornell University in photography and printmaking, and her MFA from Syracuse University in photography and video. She recently retired from more than 20 years of teaching photography and artist's books at the Maryland Institute College of Art. Laurie has exhibited at the Corcoran Gallery of Art, Cornell University, Pyramid Atlantic,

The Smithsonian Museum, Maryland Arts Council, Goucher College, Loyola University, and at the Kathleen Ewing Gallery in Washington DC, among others.

Laurie's artwork spans a variety of techniques and media. From music to pottery, photography to printmaking to books, quilts to image; art will always be central to her life. Laurie recently returned to her home in Ithaca, New York, where she continues her artistic career.

Rules & Important Information

- A \$30 non-refundable entry fee for submission of up to three works of art must be included with application.
- Exhibition is open to all artists internationally, 18 years or older.
- Maximum of 3 three original prints in any traditional or contemporary graphic process, including computer generated. Up to 10 duplicates may be included for sale. Photographs are not accepted unless computer manipulated.
- Maximum size of print 4" x 4" matted, unframed.
- Mats: Mat size must be 6" x 6" with white rag 4-ply board & mounted on same. Inside bevel must be cut at 45 degrees. Prints received unmatted will be matted at an additional cost of \$9 each mat.
- Insurance for all artwork in transport is the responsibility of the artist.
- Shipping costs to and from exhibit are the responsibility of the artist. Include sufficient funds for return postage.
- Return of Prints: Ship entries prepaid to arrive Friday, ~~CYDIA VF~~ & 2014. Include all fees, return postage and return address to:

- Jury Notice: Artists will be notified the week of September 30, 2014.
- Work not accepted after ~~CYDIA VF~~ & 2014.
- All prints not accepted will be returned at the same time as accepted work. **Return postage must be included.**
- Cash prizes of \$500, \$300, \$200 will be awarded to the top three artists, and 3 \$100 honorable mentions.
- Responsibility: All work will be handled with a maximum of care; however, the Ink Shop will assume no responsibility for any damage or loss that may occur.
- Sales: Artists are asked to price each work submitted. The Ink Shop will retain a 30% commission on all sales.

Exhibition will tour after closing at the Ink Shop Printmaking Center. There will be more information forthcoming as dates and places are finalized.
